The **Academic Writing Course** will help you to achieve better results with your thesis. This workshop set provides information, strategies and practical tools for the preparation and production of final assignments in the field of economics. Topics range from goal setting and text structure to citation and revision, so the students' writing process is accompanied by target-aimed activity and feedback opportunities.

The students get to know the standards and demands of scientific communication by practicing their academic writing. The aim is to gain a deeper understanding of how knowledge is shared, discussed and proceeded in a scientific community.

This semester the course material will be provided digitally on PANDA. Please check the material provided depending on your personal needs and progress. There will be no live session this semester. The structure of the course is as follows:

<b>Topic</b>
<i>Know the rules, set a frame and define the steps: Standards of scientific writing, possibilities of text arrangements and individual accomplishments within the writing process</i>
<i>Introduction to literature search</i>
<i>Who says what? Dealing with literature and citation standards to build a proper argumentation</i>
<i>Citation management with Citavi</i>
<i>Avoiding loose ends: Steps and criteria of text revision</i>
